Fear and Love

There is no fear in love—perfect love casts out fear! **1 John 4:18** Fear can be debilitating. Terror keeps us from doing the things that we know we could or should. Think about how these phobias would interfere with some aspect of the Christian life. These are all real phobias recognized by psychologists today.

- Aquaphobics are terrified of water. (Makes baptism tough, doesn't it?)
- Bacillophobics are more commonly called "germ-aphobes." How do they deal with a holy handshake, much less a holy kiss?
- Gerascophobes are afraid of growing old. (Their favorite hymn is "Where We'll Never Grow Old"!)
- Gerontophobes are afraid of the elderly.
- Glossophobia is one of the most common phobias: the fear of speaking in public.
- Agorophobia is the fear of being among crowds of people.
- Hexakosiohexekontahexaphobia is the fear of the number 666. If a cash register total comes up to \$6.66, these people cannot handle it. Have fun studying Revelation!
- Tokophobia is the fear of childbirth.

And of course, if you have Phobophobia, your fear is of phobias. I'm not sure what help there is for you!

When we are afraid, we begin to fixate on our fear, rather than on the One who protects us. When you are crossing a bridge over a great height, your best bet is to concentrate on the strength of the bridge, not the height of the drop. When we are afraid, we need to focus on the Savior. He'll carry us through!
