Hide and Seek

The Bible says, "and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden" (Genesis 3:8). Do you remember playing hide and seek? We used to play "Sardines" where one person hides and the group searches for the one. Instead of chasing the hider to base, you hide with that person. This game sets apart really good finders; they notice the details, the tendencies, and they walk very quietly.

Do you think God would be a good finder? He's the best of all time for one reason... He never lost you in the first place! Do you think you can hide from God? The presence of the Lord is powerful and often overwhelming in scripture. It is seen in prophets or spokespeople. It is evident in angelic messengers. The Israelites followed God's presence in the wilderness, a cloud by day and fire by night. His presence resided within the Tabernacle above the Ark of the Covenant and eventually in the Temple.

However, God's presence reaches much farther than that. He's not limited by time and space, an omnipresent being: all places at all times. This is not good for people running from Him, like Jonah (Jonah 1:3,10). On the other hand, for those who actually seek His presence, it can be a great blessing (Matthew 6:33). If we seek Him we might find he's not really all that far away (Acts 17:27-28).

The scary part of hell is not the fire and heat; it's being away from God's presence for eternity (2 Thessalonians 1:9). The sad thing: He seeks us diligently while we hide from Him. The happy thing: when we choose to seek Him instead, He's there in plain sight.
