Moses' Rod

"So the Lord said to him, 'What is that in your hand?' And he said, 'A rod'" (Exodus 4:2).

What was this rod? Likely it was a simple shepherd's staff or rod. It was made of wood and perhaps used to shepherd his sheep and to help support a man eighty years of age.

How was this rod used? "And he said, 'Cast it to the ground.' So he cast it on the ground and it became a serpent; and Moses fled from it" (Exodus 4:3). When Moses complied with God's command it became a living serpent. This same rod turned the water into blood, brought lice, brought thunder, hail and lightning. This rod brought locusts and divided the Red Sea. What a great demonstration of power!

How could a simple rod do all this? The answer is quite simple. Once Moses complied with the instructions of God, it became an instrument to do God's will. In fact, it is called the rod of God in Exodus 4:20b, "And Moses took the rod of God in his hand." By the rod Moses was convinced he was to lead the Israelites. By this the Israelites were freed from Egyptian bondage. Yes, by this rod the waters of the sea parted.

Brethren, we too should be the instruments of God to do His will. Consider these passages carefully.

"Be submissive therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you" (James 4:7).

"I have strength for every situation through the one who gives me power" (Philippians 4:13).

"What therefore shall we say against these things? If God is on our side, who is against us?" (Romans 8:31).

Our money, possessions, time and our bodies belong to God. He wants to use us to serve Him and to lead the lost to salvation. Will you be like Moses and allow that to happen? You will be richly blessed.

This Life is in His Son

Text: (1 John 5:7-12)

1. The Problems

- What do these terms mean? What is John trying to say?
- This is complicated by a textual disagreement.
- In the Council of Nicaea, 325 AD, Constantine facilitated an agreement.
- The Bible teaches Jesus, Holy Spirit, God equality (2 Cor. 13:14; Mt. 28:19).
- Notice the presence of all three parts of the Godhead (Lk. 3:22 Jn. 1:32-33).
- Notice "Spirit of God" and "Spirit of Christ" are interchangeable (Rom. 8:9).

2. Water and Blood

- "Water" = the baptism of Jesus, where the Spirit "testified" to His deity.
- "Blood" = the death of Jesus on a cross (Jn. 19:31-35).
- Apparently some in John's day were squeamish about the blood of the cross.
- The "offense" of the cross (Gal. 5:11).
- A scandal? Foolishness? Why? How? (1 Cor. 1:21-24)
- The cross of Jesus reminds me that I was a sinner (1 Jn. 1:8-10).
- The cross offends precisely because it strikes directly at our *pride*.

3. This Life is in His Son

- Of course life is about more than duration of time (Jn. 1:4).
- This is about quality of life (Jn. 20:31).
- Eternal life is found exclusively in Christ (Jn. 14:6).
