### What's in A Name?

What is a good name? (**Proverbs 22:1**) Do people recognize my name when they hear it? What thoughts come to their minds about me? Are they positive or negative? When I think of Noah (**Genesis 6**), Job (**Job 1**), and Cornelius (**Acts 10**), the thing they have in common is an excellent reputation. Can you and I say the same? Elders and Deacons are qualified and entrusted with leadership because they are found to have a good reputation inside and outside of the congregation (**1 Timothy 3:1:13**; **Titus 1:5-9**). They're known by their names.

Does my name have a meaning? Think about Isaac. How did he get his name? In many cultures names are given to reflect or imbue great meaning and significance. Christopher means the Christ bearer (No pressure!). What does that mean to me? To carry the name of Jesus everywhere I go is my life's greatest occupation. Guess What? You have the same name, the same occupation! The disciples were called Christians first at Antioch in **Acts 11:26**.

Sometimes it is very difficult to bear that name **(1 Peter 4:14-19)**. Ask yourself if it is worth going through difficult challenges here on earth in order to be glorified tremendously in the day to come. Entrust your soul to the faithful creator by doing what is right no matter what the cost.

The question we need to ask is: can Jesus put his signature on everything I do? **(Colossians 3:17)** When I send requests up to the "main office" Jesus gets to decide whether He will sign His name or not. Nothing will slip by him; he disapproves of many things that our sinful hearts and minds desire. He can have nothing to do with sin; His name must not be tainted, and as one who bears the name of Christ, I cannot ruin his good name with sinful words or actions.

What kind of power does the name of Christ have? (Philippians 2:9-10) Could invoke a different name and see how far it will take me? (Acts 4:8-12) Even our repentance and baptism are commitments we make in the name of Jesus Christ (Acts 2:38).

So what would Christ put his signature on? All other things we might want to do could very well give him a bad reputation. How valuable is his name to us? Are we willing to suffer for it? Are you and I attempting to find salvation in a name other than Jesus Christ? Choose a good name today! *Thoughts from Chris Wheat* 

### Love One Another, for Love is of God

### Text: (1 John 4:7-21)

#### Introduction:

This passage asks two important questions:

- a) Do I have to put up with people in the church even when they are unloving?
- b) If I must love them, <u>how</u>? What will give me the strength of will to do so?

#### 1. God, the Source and Motivation for Love (1 John 4:7-8)

- There is only one person for whom this statement does not seem wildly out of place!
- God does not merely <u>demonstrate</u> love, He <u>is</u> love. He *embodies* love.

#### 2. Love is Defined (1 John 4:9-11)

- Avoid the danger of substituting a human definition for God's (Matthew 5:46-47).
- Humans may love in a polluted sense; God's love is the pure original (John 13:34-35).
- As we might expect, John turns our eyes to the cross (Luke 18:13; Romans 3:25)
- Atonement removes an offense, paving the way for relationship repair (1 John 2:2).

#### 3. Loving God and Confidence (1 John 4:13-18)

- What do you fear in a relationship?
- We fear because human relationships are fickle... but God is reliable.

#### 4. The Capacity to Love (1 John 4:19)

- John is concerned about the motivation for love. How do we love our brethren?
- What will motivate us to do so?
  - a) The Bible even implies that loving people may take an enormous reserve of will.
  - b) It also implies that in our hurt, we will not have the strength to do this!

#### 5. Love in a Vacuum (1 John 4:20-21)

- Can you hear echoes of John's opponents, the Gnostics?
- They were making exalted claims about their relationship with God.
- The Christian life-style is loving, or it is nothing at all.
