High Speed Reconciliation

The Bible says, "leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift" (Matthew 5:24). I love high speed internet access! I have it at home, the office, and anywhere I go on my phone now. Isn't technology amazing? If you remember waiting for the dial tones, and pages to load, and videos to buffer, I can probably pinpoint your age fairly accurately. At the time we were just amazed at the ability to send an electronic letter across the world in a few minutes! This has probably been true for every phase of improvement in communications technology for centuries. I know the early church was thankful that someone could travel for a few weeks or days and deliver them Paul's thoughts about building healthy churches.

Jesus reminds us that the ability to communicate clearly and directly with someone and resolve a conflict or contention has actually always been something we can do in short order. What slows us down? Is it pride? Is it a lack of honesty? Is it unjustified anger and rage? Is it all of those things at once? Maybe so! If we want the problem resolved though, it may only be one difficult conversation away. This is your Christian brother or sister! Unless you're both being unreasonable about the issue, it truly can be resolved.

One of the things that slows us down the most in reconciling is our unwillingness to overlook an offense. Proverbs tells us that love and wisdom are willing to do just that, for unity, for the greater goals of God (**Proverbs 19:11; 20:3**). Peter tells us, in the midst of an unrighteous, Christian-persecuting culture, that real love is able to move past many different kinds of "sins" (**1 Peter 4:8**). These are not personality quirks and annoyances these are actual sins that can cut to the core and separate us from God. Remember, God overlooks all the offenses against Himself... He forgives us! The punishment was still enacted, there was retribution, but you and I don't have to feel it. In the blink of an eye, from our perspective (because we can simply read the words on the Bible page), God allowed all the righteous wrath generated by our sins to be inflicted on His only begotten Son! He was highly motivated, with a love I cannot fathom, to be reunited with His creation, His people, His children.

So, my friends, I know there are sins and offenses that cannot be overlooked, and Jesus gave us a plan for such situations (Matthew 18:15-17; 1 Corinthians 5:1-5). But the majority of the time, the only thing slowing down the process of reconciliation is me, my pride, and a choice to love. Let us humble ourselves before the mighty hand of God so He can lift us up in due time (1 Peter 5:6).

1. Confession is Good For the Soul (1 John 1:8-10)

- There is a sense of self-deception in these verses.
- The Laodocieans possessed a great self-image (Revelation 3:17).
- We must have an accurate, truthful understanding of God and self (Romans 12:3).
- So, confession is good for the soul literally! (James 5:16)
- How do we confess?
- There are no openings for church critic the position is already overstaffed.
- 2. Forgiveness is Absolute, With Jesus Christ (1 John 1:9)
- Jesus is faithful, just and forgives us: "As opposed to what?"

(Micah 7:18-20)

- If you think you deserved to be forgiven, you probably were not!
- 3. I Have a "Really Good" Lawyer (1 John 2:1)
- The NIV has an interesting time trying to translate the word *parakletos*.
- A fascinating term: here is a "righteous lawyer." (Romans 8:34)

4. Jesus the Atoning Sacrifice (1 John 2:2)

- Again, an unusual term, hilasmos, meaning "atonement."
- The only other time this word is used in the NT (1 John 4:10).
- We need to understand two dimensions of God.
- Our sin angered God THAT much. Jesus forgave because he loved THAT much!
