Fortunately, scripture speaks on this matter. The Bible has a more than adequate list of what a child really needs, or doesn't need, in life.

What a child needs!

Children need diligent teaching (Deuteronomy 6:4-9).

Children need to know their parents history (Psalm 78:1-9).

Children need to know that they are valuable (Psalm 127:3-5).

Children need training and discipline (Proverbs 22:6, 15; 23:13; 29:15).

Children need to appreciate what their parents sacrifice for them (Proverbs 31:28).

Children need to know the consequences (Ecclesiastes 11:9-10).

Children need trustworthy parents (Matthew 7:10-12).

Children need time for growth (Luke 2:42, 52).

Colossians 3:20 Children need to honor and obey (Ephesians 6:1-2).

Children need to be managed (1 Timothy 3:4, 12).

Children need to know the scriptures (2 Timothy 3:15).

Children need to believe (Titus 1:6).

Children need to know they are loved (Titus 2:4).

Children don't need stumbling blocks (Matthew 18:1-5).

Children don't need provocation (Ephesians 6:4; Colossians 3:21).
