#### **Precision Obedience**

The Bible says "Noah did all that the Lord had commanded him" (Genesis 7:5). Can you imagine the great detail and planning that went into constructing the ark and organizing care for the animals? The Ark story is covered in three brief chapters and the statement regarding Noah's obedience is repeated (Genesis 6:22). Even more detail is given in Exodus when God instructs Moses on the particulars of Tabernacle construction and the people were expected to carry out those commands with precision. So, the salient question is, "Does God expect that kind of careful precision obedience from us today?"

What would Jesus do? Throughout John's Gospel Jesus says He was not performing signs, teaching, and preaching of His own accord; it was his Father's will (John 4:34; 6:38; 14:31). Jesus also connected love for His Father with obeying His commands! Then he compounded the issue by telling His disciples their love could be proven through obedience as well (John 14:15). Do you suppose Noah loved God enough to obey Him as carefully as possible? What about Moses and the Israelites? What about you and me? Mechanical obedience, or that motivated by fear, may achieve a level of precision, but not the level of love God is seeking. Robotic, precision tools for manufacturing can procure a perfectly measured piece of furniture, but a craftsman can pour many hours of careful, intentional love into a piece and, though it may lack physical perfection, the one who uses or receives that furniture will appreciate its uniqueness.

Peter called us to holiness and Christ called us to perfection (1 Peter 1:14-16; Matthew 5:48). The holiness we must reflect comes from Christ and He's insisting we be perfected in our love first and foremost, then our obedience will follow. Precision obedience of the Mosaic law was an impossible challenge unless properly motivated; the same is true of following Christ's law. If we love Him, we will obey him in the most careful, diligent manner possible. This love proves to others the validity of Faith in Christ (John 13:34-35). Carefully craft a masterpiece of loving obedience in service to the Father and show others how Christ's love has changed your motivation.
